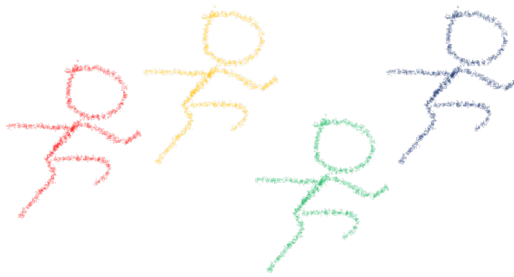
# ABOUT

"Shutter" is a personal speedrun tour of the Art Institute of Chicago.

Each work on the tour is approached with two cameras: one impractical camera (a hand-held video game console) and a different camera to photograph the impractical camera.

The tour is driven mainly by TIME and SOUND as well as SHEER, SUBCONCIOUS WHIM.

- TIME: The museum is 30 minutes away from closing for the day.
- SOUND: the impractical camera is impractical for many reasons, one of which includes its shutter sound which (as far as I know) cannot be muted. It makes a loud 'CLICK' preceded by one of several noises: BARK, MEOW, (REVEILLE), (A COPYRIGHTED THEME), & ROOSTER CROWING. These are selected before taking a picture or set to the 'random selection' settings. While those sounds can be turned off, the shutter 'CLICK' absolutely cannot be.
